Temporary email addresses will reduce your SPAM!

Have you ever gone to a website that asks for your email address? (We all have...) You know that the moment you give it away, it might be streaming across the Internet, on its way to every spam database in the world. **You simply can't be that careless with your personal email-address anymore.**

If this is a concern to you there are a few options: First, use adequate SPAM filtering software. Second, **create a second mail account** just for junk mail (many people use their Hotmail account for that) or you could give MAILINATOR a try.

MAILINATOR is a 'Disposable Email-Address Website'. It is very easy to use, there is no sign up process and best of all... it's FREE!

All you need to do is to provide your MAILINATOR email-address when you do not wish the recipient to have your real email-address. Your MAILINATOR email-address is any name up to 15 characters followed by @mailinator.com. To check for replies visit the MAILINATOR website and type the chosen email-address in the field marked "Check your Inbox here!" Then click 'Go', and you will be taken to your inbox.

There is even no password to remember, and MAILINATOR deletes emails from your inbox a few hours after you check it. Not having a password may pose a security concern (others might be able to read the email if they guess the correct email-address), but since you'll be using this email-address just once, who cares!

Other sites that provide disposable e-mail address services are:

- Dodgeit.com, no set up, free
- Mailexpire.com, clean and simple, free
- PookMail.com, no registration, very simple to use.
- SpamGourmet.com, requires registration, provides mail forwarding, can create custom aliases which automatically expire after a certain number of e-mails received.

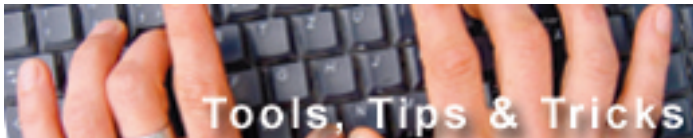

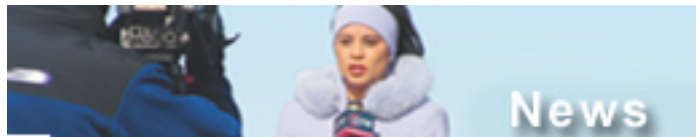
How clean is your keyboard?

Does your keyboard look like it needs some serious cleaning? Here's how to do it safely:

1. Shut down your computer and detach the keyboard connector before any cleaning procedure. Do not remove or connect a keyboard while the computer is running. Doing so may damage the machine.
2. For a quick cleaning, turn the keyboard upside down and use a can of compressed air to blow out any foreign matter. Be sure to do this in a location where falling debris can be cleaned up easily.
3. For a more thorough cleaning, use a moist (NOT WET) disinfectant wipe to surface clean the keys. Even sterile water works. And one class of disinfectants, which includes Sani-Cloth Plus, Cavi-Wipes and Clorox Disinfecting Wipes, keep bacteria from re-growing for two days or more. None of the compounds will harm the keyboard, and the computer remains functional.

Spam is now more than 77% of all Email worldwide.

Spam has reached an all-time high of 77 per cent of email traffic in Canada and the U.S., according to recent Internet Security research.

"It's a remarkable thing!" Jordan Kalpin, Canadian regional director for IBM Internet Security Systems, said last month after IBM released a comprehensive security report.

An inside source at Sasktel mentioned that in March 2007, the amount of spam peaked to over 90% at a few days in March, a new and actually... sad record.

The best way for small and medium sized companies to mitigate this problem, is to subscribe to an on-line email clearing house like MX Logic. However, spam control can be a cat-and-mouse game because the spammers are constantly figuring out ways around it.

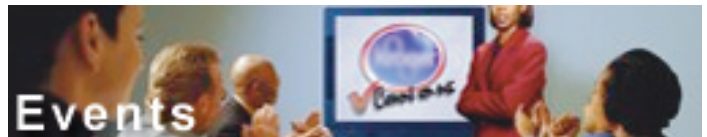
